Sermon Notes

TRIUMPH OVER TROUBLE PSALM 46 + JUNE 19, 2016

I. First, God's <u>Protection</u> when trouble comes: God is for us: a refuge, strength, and ever present help in time of trouble. Therefore we will not fear. (vs.1-3)

II. Second, God's <u>Power</u> when trouble comes: God is our strength, therefore we will not be moved. (vs. 4-6)

III. Third, God's <u>Presence</u> when trouble comes: God is by our side, therefore we will not be alone. (vs. 7)

IV. Finally, God's <u>Peace</u> when trouble comes: God gives us inward peace, therefore we will not strive. (vs.8-11)
