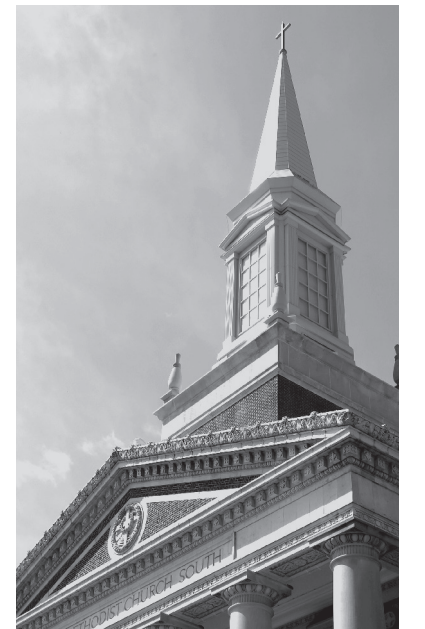

Sermon Notes

TAKING THE “UN” OUT OF UNHAPPY
PSALM 100 • JULY 24, 2016

I. First, identify and eliminate the “un” from your life.

II. Second, drop the negative thinking - don’t allow negative events or thoughts to bring you down.

III. Third, avoid what holds your happiness hostage - primarily worry and negative thinking.

IV. Fourth, put things in perspective - tap into the power of gratitude.

V. Finally, ask God for help to transform you by the renewing of your mind.
